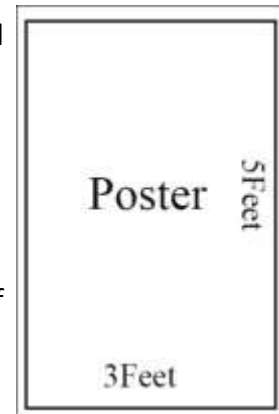

## GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PREPARATION

- ❖ Poster should be prepared in the given size of 3 feet width and 5 feet height (in a portrait form).
- ❖ Preferred fonts are Arial and Calibri.
- ❖ Texts should be concise, and in bullets instead of paragraph.
- ❖ Poster should be readable within 5-7 minutes from a distance of 5 feet.
- ❖ Title of the poster should appear at the top.
- ❖ Author(s) name(s) and affiliation(s) should be kept below the title.
- ❖ Include logos of funding institutions or agencies and/or your host institution (if relevant).
- ❖ Use color to enhance comprehension, not to decorate the poster.
- ❖ Use pictures, diagrams, cartoons, figures etc. wherever necessary.
- ❖ A few pictures can be added and photographs should be of high resolution (at least 300 dpi).
- ❖ Plan your poster in logical sequence ie. Title page, Introduction (Background, Rationale), Objectives, Study Area, Research Design, Materials and Methods, Results and Conclusion.
- ❖ Focus on major findings and include only necessary information.
- ❖ Check spellings and grammatical errors before printing.



## SOME INFORMATION FOR THE POSTER PRESENTERS

- ❖ Your poster must correspond to the title and content of the abstract you submitted.
- ❖ All authors should print and bring their posters with them to the conference.
- ❖ All authors should find the board label with their name below and mount their poster.
- ❖ When possible, please stand by your poster during sessions to answer questions.
- ❖ You should remove your poster as informed during the conference.
